
We will:

DAY ONE • MONDAY, FEBRUARY 6 • DEPARTURE

DAY TWO • TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 7 • ARRIVAL

ARRIVAL *Today we arrive in Tel Aviv. We will be met and assisted through customs and introduced to our guide and driver.*

SHILOH *Originally the location of the Ark of the Covenant, it's here the high priest Eli lived and the prophet Samuel grew to manhood.*

DAY FOUR • THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 9 • CAESAREA

CAESAREA *Begin your day in the land by exploring the Roman theater, harbor, newly excavated hippodrome, and palace—all built by Herod the Great in the days of Jesus.*

MOUNT CARMEL *View the western end of the Jezreel Valley from atop Mount Carmel where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal.*


MEGIDDO *Explore the remarkable excavations and water tunnel at this chariot city of King Solomon, including a view of the gathering place of the nations at Armageddon.*

MOUNT ARBEL *Experience from these spectacular cliffs a sweeping overview of the Sea of Galilee and the biblical sites of Jesus' public ministry.*

DAY FIVE • FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 10 • AROUND THE SEA OF GALILEE

CAPERNAUM *Walk the adopted hometown streets of Jesus, passing the remains of Peter's house, where Jesus based his adult ministry and the synagogue where He preached.*

MOUNT OF BEATITUDES *Where Christ delivered the Sermon on the Mount.*

DAY FIVE • FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 10 • CONTINUED


- CAESAREA PHILIPPI** Stand in the pagan Roman worship center where Peter made his famous profession, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God."
- BANIAS WATERFALL** Take an optional hike down an old rock staircase to a spectacular waterfall with lush vegetation at the headwaters of the Jordan River near the foot of Mount Hermon.
- SEA OF GALILEE** Climb aboard a replica of an ancient boat from Jesus' time for a worship service on this famous freshwater lake.
- ANCIENT GALILEE BOAT** See firsthand the discovered remains of an ancient fishing boat dating to the time of Jesus.
- SUNSET BAPTISM** Those interested will have the opportunity to be baptized at a quiet sunset service on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.


DAY SIX • SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 11 • THE JORDAN VALLEY TO JERUSALEM

- BET SHE'AN / SCYTHOPOLIS** Explore the extensive Roman city seated in the shadow of the hill where the Philistines once displayed the slain bodies of King Saul and his sons.
- PENIEL / MAHANA'IM** Drive through the Jordan River Valley as we discuss the Samaritan hill country of the Palestinian West Bank, as well as the modern State of Jordan where Jacob wrestled with the angel of God.
- JERICO** We will see a 10,000 year old watchtower along the crumbled walls of the ancient Canaanite city of Jericho, Israel's first conquest.
- SHEPHERDS' FIELD** View this serene hillside while reflecting on the angelic announcement of the birth of Jesus.
- BETHLEHEM** Come as a pilgrim to the Church of the Nativity, built near the place of Jesus' birth in the "Little Town of Bethlehem."
- BETHLEHEM BIBLE COLLEGE** Hear firsthand about one of the most important evangelical ministries in Palestine today, touching many students and families for Jesus in a predominately Jewish and Muslim environment.
- UP TO JERUSALEM** Ascend by bus to the immortal city of Jerusalem, a city like none other!

DAY SEVEN • SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 12 • INTRODUCTION TO JERUSALEM

- MOUNT OF OLIVES** Savor the most famous panoramic vista of the Old City of Jerusalem in anticipation of the days still ahead of us in the Holy Land.
- DOMINUS FLEVIT** Walk down the paved path of this historic hillside and stop at a small church that remembers where Jesus wept over Jerusalem.
- WORSHIP SERVICES** This morning we will worship with Palestinian believers within the Old City of Jerusalem.





DAY SEVEN • SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 12 • CONTINUED

CITY OF DAVID Explore the ruins of the original Canaanite city of Jebuse, which David made "Jerusalem," the ancient capital of Israel.

WARREN'S SHAFT See the water shaft that David's general Joab climbed to capture this city.

HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL Take an optional walk through this historic and amazing tunnel dug by Hezekiah to survive the Assyrian siege of Jerusalem.

POOL OF SILOAM See the place where the blind man washed the mud off his eyes and received his sight from Jesus.

PRAYER AT WESTERN WALL Tonight we will have prayer and teaching at the Jews' most sacred site, also known as the Wailing Wall.

DAY EIGHT • MONDAY, FEBRUARY 13 • AROUND JERUSALEM

THE TEMPLE MOUNT Enter the grounds where the second Jewish Temple once stood and now the home of the most sacred Muslim sites in Jerusalem: the Dome of the Rock and Al Aqsa Mosque.

SOUTHERN TEMPLE STEPS Explore the extensive excavations of the southern steps of the Temple Mount, indeed some of the very steps on which Jesus walked.

RABBINICAL TUNNEL Explore the excavations of the Roman City that now run under today's Old City and along the Western Wall dating back to the time of Christ.

HEBRON Take a drive south past Hebron, one of the most important Judean cities in the biblical and modern era.

JUDEAN HILL COUNTRY Wind your way through this beautiful hill country, once known as the Southern Kingdom of Judah.

DAY NINE • TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 14 • THE WILDERNESS

DOWN TO THE DEAD SEA Descend by bus to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on the face of the earth. Drive along its shores and witness dramatic evidence of the ancient earthquake activity that shaped this unique geological phenomenon.

MASADA Ride a cable car to the 1,300-foot heights of Herod's lavish palace and fortress where Jewish zealots made a final stand in their revolt against Rome.



DAY NINE • TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 14 • CONTINUED

EIN BOKEK Consider the failure and judgment of Sodom and Gomorrah as we continue our drive along the shores of the Dead Sea.

OASIS OF EIN GEDI We will take a brief hike across streams and rocks to the caves and waterfall where, in his exile, David encountered King Saul, or just relax in the nature reserve with the deer and rock badgers.

QUMRAN Visit the site where the most important manuscript discovery of the modern era was made—the Dead Sea Scrolls.

WADI QILT We will enter into the Judean Wilderness just outside of Jerusalem to consider Christ's time of temptation prior to entering into His ministry.


DAY TEN • WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 15 • ISRAEL, THEN & NOW

RAMPART'S WALL We will wind around the Old City of Jerusalem atop the ancient walls to pray for the "Peace of Jerusalem" starting at Jaffa Gate and ending at Zion Gate.

SAINT PETER IN GALICANTU Relive the trial of Jesus at the traditional site of Caiaphas' House.

KING OF KINGS PRAYER TOWER Today we will have the unique opportunity to participate in a "Prayer Watch" overlooking Mea Shearim.

YAD VASHEM Contemplate one of the great tragedies of modern history at Israel's memorial to the six million Jews killed in the Holocaust.

DAY ELEVEN • THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 16 • THE SAVIOR

LIONS' GATE Begin our remembrance of Passion Week at Stephen's Gate, the traditional place of the stoning of the first Christian martyr.

POOL OF BETHESDA & SAINT ANNE'S CHURCH See the pools where Jesus healed an infirmed man, and worship at the finest remnant of a Crusader church in the Holy Land.

ANTONIO'S FORTRESS Weep at the place where Jesus was mocked by the soldiers and a crown of thorns was placed upon His head.

VIA DOLOROSA Journey the traditional "Way of the Cross" to the holy Christian site, where Jesus gave His life for mere mortals like us.

GORDON'S CALVARY The hill of Golgotha, or Place of the Skull, is known as one of the traditional sites of Jesus' crucifixion.

THE GARDEN TOMB Walk into an ancient tomb similar to the one in which Christ was buried and then have a communion service celebrating the resurrection of our Savior... "He is not here! He has risen!"

FAREWELL DINNER Tonight you will enjoy your final dinner and spend time rejoicing and reminiscing over the extraordinary days spent in the land of our Lord.

DAY TWELVE • FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 17 • HOMEWARD BOUND

Hotels—First-class hotels throughout, double occupancy.

Sightseeing—As itinerary specifies, in deluxe motorcoaches with English-speaking guide.

All entrance fees are included.

Transfers—All group transfers between airports and hotels.

Reservations—A deposit of \$750 must accompany the reservation form for each participant enrolling in the tour. An additional partial payment of \$1,500 is due by October 10, 2011. Final payment is due by November 15, 2011.

Tour Prices—All tour prices are based on costs, charges, taxes and US dollar exchange rates known at the time of booking. We regret should any of these costs change, a surcharge may be added to the cost of your tour. You would be notified prior to travel.

expiration not less than 6 months after your return to the US. It takes about eight to twelve weeks to secure a passport so don't delay.
